Reimbursement Program

The NY Main Street program is a reimbursement program and projects CAN be reimbursed up to 75% of project costs after the project is complete, and paid in full as evidenced by paid invoices and cancelled checks. If there is greater demand from the program, reimbursement may be less than 75%. To be competitive in the application, we would prefer a 50% reimbursement on projects. If you are able to provide proof of funding for the project that will greatly increase your likelihood of obtaining an award. If available, please attach a bank letter or proof of funds available for the project.

Environmental Compliance

Before proceeding with the project New York State will require compliance with an Environmental Checklist including, but not limited to, NY State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) approval, local zoning, site disturbance, lead-based paint, and asbestos. No work can begin on site until approval is given after the environmental review process is complete.

Bidding Requirements

This program requires a fair bidding process for all contractors hired to perform the work involved. Additionally, the project must be made available to MWBE and SDVOB contractors. The program administrator will help with this process however it is important to note that contractors cannot be preselected, and the work cannot be completed by the property owner. Further requirements and regulations can be provided upon request.
